In our Psalm from this morning we prayed:

"In my distress I called upon the Lord, and he heard my voice." (Psalm 18).

So the question: are we calling upon the Lord?

You and me, we are called to be the light in the darkness. But we can only ever do this through God. Something that we need to turn back to is the power of God. Our Lord will do great, heroic things through us when we turn back to Him. Think of the Old Testament: how he was constantly saving and redeeming His people Israel; how he stood with the innocent; how he created an absolutely magnificent world from nothing. Think of Jesus: he changed the world with a small group of fisherman who were often pretty clueless, how He healed people after years of pain and suffering, how He forgives sins that people hang onto for years.

In and through Christ, we are called to do the same thing. We can, God can, change this world, can destroy the evil, bring light to the darkness. And this is a non-negotiable for us as Christians. So my encouragement: what is a movement that you can support, who is someone you pray for, what is an evil which you can confront this Holy Week. Starting today: pray for that each day.

Each day call on the Lord. He wants to do great things through you. The question is do we firmly believe that God hears me and wants to work through us?
